Patient Information Leaflet

For Patients of Farnham Road and Weekes Drive Surgeries

This is a new, confidential, comprehensive Nurse-led Sexual Health and Contraception Service to female patients over 16 years of age.

The Clinic will provide:

- Contraception Advice**
- Contraception by Injection**
- Contraceptive Pill Repeat Prescriptions**
- Emergency Contraception**
- IUCD Coil Checks**
- Sexual Health Advice**

Please note:

Contraceptive Procedures such as Implants or the fitting of an IUCD will need a referral to a Farnham Road GP specialising in this service. Please ask at Reception on how to arrange this.

Clinic Times & Dates

Clinics will be held in the evenings and at week-ends to make it accessible for women, especially those working or in full-time education.

Clinic dates will vary on a week-to-week basis on one evening session per week and two weekend sessions per month. All clinics will be by prior appointment only and will be held at:

Clinic Exclusions

Please note that the Clinic will not be able to provide:

- Investigations, treatment or referral for gynaecological problems (this requires a referral from your GP – please make an appointment as usual with your GP).
- Prescriptions for medication other than for contraceptive methods (please make an appointment as usual with your GP).
- Care for general medical issues – again, please make an appointment as usual with your GP.
- More complex problems may be referred to your local Genito-Urinary Medicine Clinic at The Garden Clinic, Upton Hospital, Albert Street, Slough, SL1 2BJ.
- The clinic will not provide the services to patients under the age of 16years.
